What would I do?

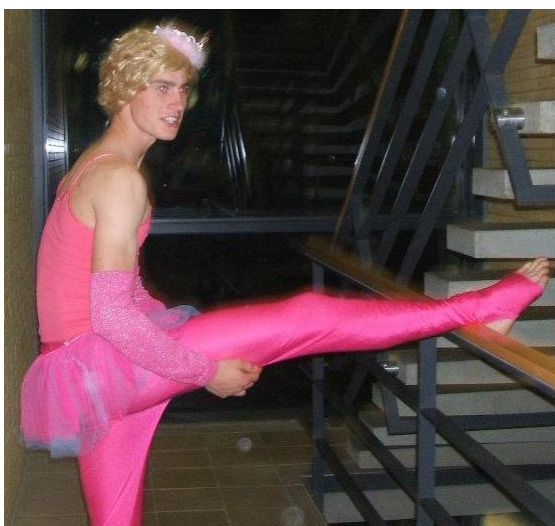
